This Notice explains how Kroo Bank Ltd ("we", "us", and "ours" or "Kroo") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit www.Kroo.com (the "Website"). The Notice explains what these cookies are, how we use them and how you can manage your cookie preferences in line with your legal rights.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website.

Cookies are widely used by websites in order to improve efficiency, as well as to collect analytics information or remember your preferences. Cookies set by the website owner (in this case Kroo) are called "first party cookies". Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called "third party cookies". Third party cookies enable third party features or functionality to be provided on or through the Website (e.g. advertising, interactive content and analytics). The parties that set these third party cookies can recognise your computer when you visit the website in question and also when you visit certain other websites.

Why do we use cookies?

We use cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for our Website to operate, and we refer to these as "essential" or "strictly necessary" cookies. Other cookies also enable us to track the use of our Website. This is described in more detail below.

Our Website uses cookies and similar technologies to distinguish you from other users of the Website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse and also allows us to improve our Website.

What types of cookies do you use?

Necessary cookies

These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our site.

Analytics and performance cookies

These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors on our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by remembering the user's previous interactions with and navigation around the Website and other technical details about the device/browser used to access the Website. The analytics may include, but are not limited to, traffic data, location data, logs, error and crash reports, and other communication data and the services that you access.

These cookies may also capture information available about your usage or configuration of your mobile device, including the presence of other applications, unique device-identifying information, and any cellular network, IP, wifi, Bluetooth data or similar technology.

Advertisement cookies

These cookies record your visit to our Website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed including unique IP addresses or device identifiers associated with mobiles devices, and sites visited before or after visiting our Website. We will use this information to make our Website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

Third parties

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

What about other tracking technologies, like web beacons?

Cookies are not the only way to recognise or track visitors to a website. Some websites use similar technologies from time to time, like web beacons (sometimes called "tracking pixels" or "clear gifs"). These are tiny graphics files that contain a unique identifier that enable website owners to recognise when someone has visited their website or opened an email sent to them. This allows website owners, for example, to monitor the traffic patterns of users from one page to another within the website, to deliver or communicate with cookies. We do use facebook pixel, which is a form of tracking technology.

Do you use social networking cookies?

These cookies are used to enable you to share pages and content that you find interesting on our Website through third party social networking and other websites. We do not use these types of cookies.

Links to other websites

Our Website contains links to other websites. If you access those other websites they may use cookies. Please read any cookie privacy notices on those websites if you wish to know what cookies are being used.

How can I control cookies?

You can use your web browser to:

- delete all cookies;
- block all cookies;
- allow all cookies;
- block 'third-party' cookies (ie, cookies set by online services other than the one you are visiting);
- clear all cookies when you close the browser;
- open a 'private browsing' / 'incognito' session, which allows you to browse the
 web without recording your browsing history or storing local data such as cookies
 (you should however be aware of the limitations of this feature in a privacy
 context); and

• install add-ons and plugins that extend browser functionality.

How often will you update this Cookie Notice?

We may update this Cookie Notice from time to time in order to reflect, for example, changes to the cookies we use or for other operational, legal or regulatory reasons.

Please therefore re-visit this Cookie Notice regularly to stay informed about our use of cookies and related technologies.
